ORDINANCE NO. 852

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 91, ENTITLED "ANIMALS", OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, BY SPECIFICALLY CREATING SECTION 91.17 TO BE ENTITLED "BIRD SANCTUARY", DECLARING AND RECOGNIZING THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, AS A BIRD SANCTUARY DEDICATED TO PROTECTING AND PRESERVING BIRDS AND OTHER RELATED WILDLIFE IN THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA; PROVIDING THAT IT SHALL BE ILLEGAL TO HUNT, WOUND, MOLEST, INJURE, CAPTURE OR KILL BIRDS AND OTHER RELATED WILDLIFE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida, understands that it is within the power of the citizens and residents of the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida, to protect the health and well-being of birds and other related wildlife in the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida, further believes that protection and preservation of birds and other related wildlife is an important part of our civilized culture; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida, wishes to set forth standards which will insure that birds are protected by declaring the City of Pembroke Pines, and all lands embracing same, as a Bird Sanctuary;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. Chapter 91, entitled "Animals", of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida, is hereby amended to create Section 91.17 which shall read as follows:

Section 91.17 BIRD SANCTUARY.

(A) The City of Pembroke Pines is hereby declared a Bird Sanctuary.

- be unlawful to hunt, wound, molest, injure or kill any birds or related wildlife in the lands embracing the City of Pembroke Pines.
- (C) It shall be unlawful to capture except for the preservation of the health and welfare of the public, for resale or private use any birds or related wildlife in the City of Pembroke Pines.
- (D) The penalty for each of the above offenses shall be One Hundred Dollars of the above (\$100.00) for each occurrence.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, Section 2. Resolutions or parts of Resolutions, in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

If any clause, section or other part or Section 3. application of this Ordinance shall be held by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part or application shall be considered as eliminated to the extent of such invalidity, and shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications of this Ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect.

Ordinance shall become effective Section 4. This immediately upon its passage and adoption.
